

PAPER PINATA



What You Need

paper lunch sacks (1 per child) magazine or newspaper tissue paper scissors, glue & tape yarn & hole punch candy

What You Do

FILL THE PAPER BAG WITH CANDY (MAKE SURE IT'S NOT TOO HEAVY TO HANG.)

Crinkle the newspapers to fill the bag the rest of the way. Fold over the top of the bag and secure with TAPE.

Cut the tissue paper into strips that are long enough to wrap around the paper bag. Cut fringe along the long edge of one side of the tissue paper strips.

Using glue or tape, secure a piece of fringed tissue paper around the bag. The tissue paper fringe should slightly hang over the bottom of the bag. Repeat with another strip of fringed tissue paper, overlapping the previous strip just slightly. Continue until your entire bag is covered.

PUNCH TWO HOLES AT THE TOP AND SECURE A PIECE OF YARN TO CREATE A HANDLE FOR YOUR PINATA.

CUT SEVERAL MORE STRIPS OF TISSUE PAPER TO CREATE STEAMERS TO HANG OFF THE BOTTOM OF THE PINATA.
